

On behalf of PenAir, this brochure will assist you in preparation for your hunting or sport fishing adventure.



Plan Ahead

Planning ahead can make your trip more cost-effective. Most discounted fares are limited in number and have advance reservation and purchase requirements.

Reconfirm

Call to reconfirm reservations at least 24 hours in advance. Flight departure times are occasionally modified because of schedule changes.

Check In Early

Allow yourself plenty of extra time by arriving at the airport early. We recommend 60-90 minutes before departure. Make sure that your name, address, and telephone number are attached to ALL your luggage (both inside and out), including carryon bags. Remove any old bag tags attached to your luggage from previous trips.

Free Baggage Allowance

Each ticketed passenger is allowed two checked bags and one carry-on bag. Each checked bag may weigh up to 50 lbs. and have a maximum size of 62 linear inches (length + width + height). A charge is assessed for each piece of luggage that exceeds maximum size or weight limits, and each additional piece over the two free which are allowed. **Whenever a fee is charged for luggage, it travels on a space available basis.** Items in excess of maximum weight or dimension allowances may be shipped as air cargo. When traveling with more baggage than the free allowance, consider shipping your gear in advance.

With the type and size of the aircraft that PenAir operates, PenAir cannot always guarantee that your luggage will travel with you due to weight and balance of the aircraft. We will endeavor to provide the best service possible, and our performance is generally outstanding. PenAir strongly recommends that passengers with extra luggage ship in advance to their final destination and/or lodge. Our Cargo Service Agents will be happy to assist by answering specific questions.

Baggage Liability

Each ticketed passenger traveling on a U.S. domestic trip is covered to a maximum of \$1250 for loss to luggage or articles contained inside (refer to list of excluded items below). If the cost of replacing your luggage or packed belongings exceeds the maximum compensation amount, you may want to declare a higher value by purchasing "excess valuation." Excess valuation is simply an extension of liability in the event of loss or damage, up to a maximum of \$5000. Excess valuation may be purchased for some fragile items, and liability extends to loss only. If you purchase excess valuation, you will be asked to describe the contents of the bag. Excess valuation is not insurance. Insurance is available for cargo shipments only.

Excluded items

The following items are not covered for loss or damage, and excess valuation cannot be purchased. Acceptance of these articles or any similar valuables is entirely at your own risk. Ship them in advance as air cargo unless they will fit under your seat onboard.

- Telescopes
- Binoculars
- Cameras
- Personal Electronic Devices

Many other items are excluded from liability. Call our reservation office for specifics.

Perishable Items

Spoiled or damaged perishables are not covered and excess valuation cannot be purchased.

Prohibited for Use Onboard Aircraft

These items may be carried onboard but are not allowed to be turned on at any time:

- Any type of radio (AM, FM, VHF, CB)
- Global Positioning Systems (GPS)
- Cellular phones

Prohibited Articles

Baggage may not contain hazardous materials or other prohibited articles. This includes:

- Flammable items such as fuel, (sterno, butane, white gas, propane, lighter fluid) for stoves, lanterns, motors, etc.
- Strike-anywhere matches
- Personal protection devices such as tear gas and mace. PenAir does allow bear spray to be transported; however, this must be declared at the ticket counter as special shipping requirements must be met.
- Over 50 lbs. of ammunition. Ammunition must be declared at the ticket counter.
- Wet ice
- Over 5 lbs. of dry ice
- Styrofoam containers are never permitted as checked baggage!

Sporting Equipment

Below is a list of sporting equipment that may be checked as one of the free pieces in the normal baggage allowance. When checking sporting equipment in addition to the free baggage allowance, an excess fee is charged. These items must be packed in suitable containers. **All excess is shipped space available.**

Archery Equipment

1 bow and 24 arrows

Fishing Equipment

2 rods, 1 reel, 1 landing net, 1 pair boots and 1 tackle box. Fishing rods are allowed as carry-on baggage only when they can be taken apart and stowed in the overhead bin.

Shooting Equipment

- (a) 1 rifle case with no more than 2 rifles including scopes, 1 shooting mat, noise suppressors and small tools, or
- (b) 1 shotgun case with no more than 2 shotguns (not to exceed 50 lbs. otherwise excess fees apply), or
- (c) 1 pistol case with a maximum of 5 pistols, noise suppressors, 1 pistol telescope and small pistol tools.
